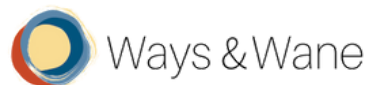

- Gives conversation starters for end-of-life planning with an older adult

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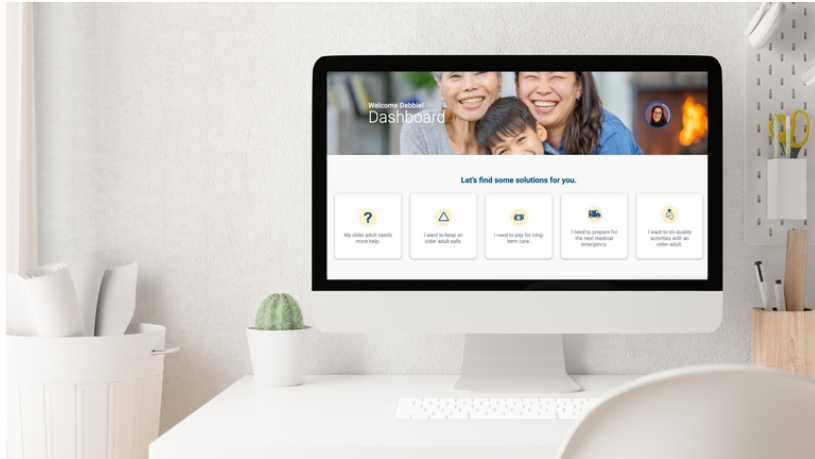

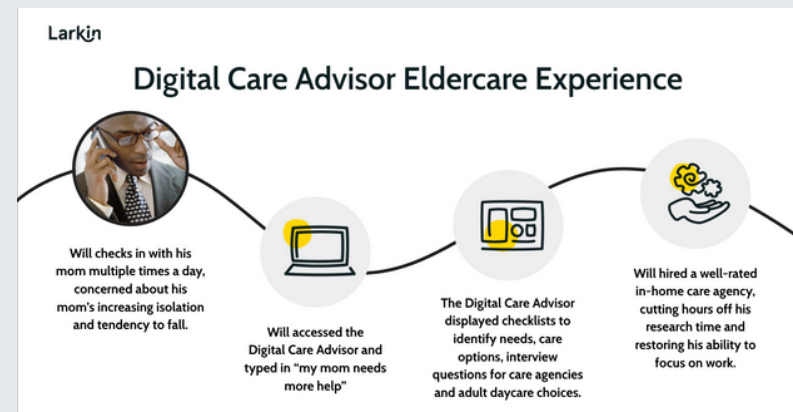


Replace late-night online searches with a custom eldercare plan

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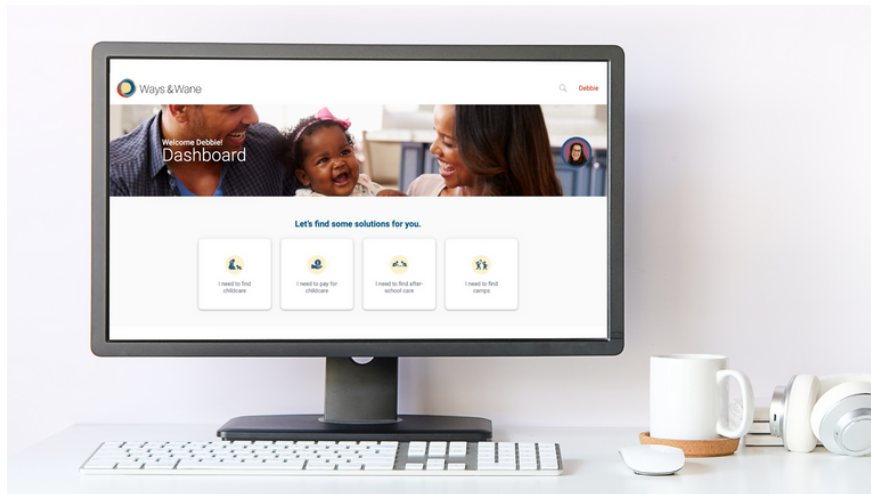
